





2.2. Organization and Facilities

Within the university there are five faculties:

1. FACULTY OF LAW
2. FACULTY OF ECONOMICS
3. FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES
4. FACULTY OF INFORMATICS
5. FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE

University comprised of several organizational forms where students can receive various types of technical support within their jurisdiction as follows:

- Student Affairs Office,
- Service for Legal and Personnel Affairs,
- Department of Finance and Material Operation,
- Public Relations Office,
- International Relations Office and
- Students Career Center.



Facilities and equipments of the University aim to provide a better mastery of subject disciplines to students, and the most sophisticated equipment allows to the teaching staff in most useful way to transfer and connect theoretical knowledge and practice, which will prepare them to be able to bear the social responsibilities in their professional competence, in areas of origin.

International VISION University serves with 6 amphitheatres equipped with digital smart boards used for presentations, 15 classrooms equipped with projectors to perform presentations, one computer lab, digital study room which is part of the Library, as well as premises that houses the staff of the student services for each faculty.



2.3. Bologna Declaration

The challenges faced by modern universities are founded before the requirements of companies correlativity between practice and education, and even before the internationalization and integration of research processes that are essential for economic development and social value system.

Bologna process is the reform of higher education in Europe, which aims to promote mobility of students and teachers within the European higher education system by 2010.

This process officially started with the signing of a joint declaration by the European Ministers of Education in Bologna in 19 June 1999. The declaration was signed by 29 countries, referring to the reform of higher education in Europe, and hence is known as the «Bologna process».

The Bologna process is a series of documents and declarations, beginning with Magna Charta Universitatum (18.09.1988), presenting the basic principles of the establishment, construction and activities of universities, and followed by other documents relating to the educational process as : the Lisbon Convention (1997), the Sorbonne declaration (1998), the Bologna declaration (1999), Salamanca Convention (2001), Prague (2002), Berlin (2003), Bergen (2005) and London (2007) communique, the conference in Leuven (2009), Budapest and Vienna (2010).

Signing the Bologna Declaration Republic of Macedonia has undertaken to accept the principles of the Magna Charta Universitatum, which mostly means readiness which our country manifest the sole intention to achieve common goals in the field of higher education in the EU.

Bologna process in higher education is based on two main cycles of study: a) undergraduate (first cycle) and b) postgraduate (second cycle).

2.3.2. Mobility

Mobility includes the freedom of students to choose the institution that will continue their studies, temporarily or permanently. Mobility also applies to the academic and scientific staff. Some of the benefits of mobility to wider employment opportunities, development of scientific research, exchange and training of teachers, gaining new experiences and cohesion between peoples. European mobility programs for students include Socrates, Leonardo da Vinci, Erasmus Mundus, Tempus and others.

2.3.3 EKTC

European Credit Transfer System is a system of academic recognition of studies based on: information on study programs and student achievement, mutual trust units of the university or research institutions of the University, the mutual agreement of the partner institutions of the University and other institutions in the country and abroad which use the credits (points) as a measure of student workload.

Credit transfer system is applied to exercise all study programs at the university and its units have relative numeric value that defines the subject programs, which describe the quantity of student work in relation to the total quantum of work necessary to complete one academic year of the university unit.

Accordingly, the three-year studies of first cycle total need a minimum of 180 credits, for four years' studies of first cycle require a minimum of 240 credits, the university studies of second cycle accumulate at least 300 credits (including the first + second cycle) and university of third cycle studies accumulate at least 480 credits (first + second + third together).



2.4 Lifelong Learning Center

Lifelong Learning Center implements projects in the field of adult education and lifelong learning and daily follow the trends in the labor market in the country and prepare, coordinate, implement and carry out activities with learning throughout the life of adults.

Its activities aim to promote the knowledge, skills and abilities of adults, as well as development of competences and qualifications in order to increase their professional development to create perspective for competitiveness in the job market. In this direction it focuses to projects that will contribute to a social inclusion in society, economic progress, growth and development of the quality and standards of the workforce in the labor market.

2.5. Career Center

The Career Center provides the linkage between the students of our faculty and the business community where we work with prospective, current and graduated students from our university. It gives the students the potential to get know the



possibilities of studying at university and redirect them when choosing the appropriate study program, as well as for the preparation for enrollment. Students studying their help in making their career in finding work in some state or private institutions, depending on their level and quality of knowledge and skills, and personal affinities. We help the students for carrying out the practical work, at home and abroad. Also the career center mediates between the demands of companies for internships and interest of students to carry out their practical work.



2.6. Opportunities for Practical Teaching (Internship)

The best path for the recruitment is through a program of a practical training (Internship). We encourage our students to apply to this program, and also we encourage the companies to provide the qualified practical training for our students.

4.1.1. The Mission of the Faculty of Law


4.5.1 Vision and Principles

**SERVICES SUPPORTING
STUDENTS' ACTIVITIES**

5.1. Student Affairs Office

Each faculty at the International Vision University has a special student service that is available to students at the specified terms, every day from 00 :17-30 :8 pm. In student services students can register semesters, receive a certificate confirming their student status and other documents applied in cases they need, and any relevant information about their studies.

At the beginning of each semester, students submit all the necessary documents for registration of semester, until the end once they collect all the signatures from the subject professors, subject disciplines who listened in the current semester to submit applications for certification of the semester, they can obtain this service. Student documents are available also in the electronic form since the students of our university may perform their verification of semester in a electronic form.

For more information, students can directly contact the student office or visit the website of the university where they can find the necessary information or contact details of authorized persons such information can give.

5.1.1. Enrollment Conditions

Students can enroll in three or four years of studies, depending on the curricula of faculties, after they pass the entrance exam organized by the university. The first cycle of study may enroll candidates who have completed the secondary school of education.

The first enrollment period begins in early June and lasts until the 30th of the month, while the second session starts from the 1th of July and lasts until the 31th of August. And the third session for enrollment takes from the 1th to the 31th of September.

5.1.2. Documents Required for Registration

The candidate is obliged to submit a petition to compete for enrollment of study and must appoint a study program teaching language, and if applying for regular or open university of studies.

Besides the application, the applicant shall submit all documents referred to in the competition and is necessary for enrollment in the study program that is the subject of his choice. Are eligible to apply as domestic and foreign nationals.

University offers admission to students who transferred from other higher education institutions in the country and abroad. For students who will continue their studies at International VISION University and come from domestic universities, among other documents they need to bring are proof of passed exams and acquired credits, while foreign students are obliged to submit a document committing equivalence of the respective committee for the recognition of exams.

5.1.3. Entrance Examination

University has the right to conduct an entrance exam in the manner, place and to the extent he or she determines. The results of the entrance examination, candidates are notified in writing or via the notice board of the University.

5.1.4. Academic Calendar

The studies are implemented in accordance with the academic calendar, which is published at the beginning of each academic year. The academic calendar is prepared by Vice Rector Responsible for Education and International Cooperation Affairs. According to the decision to launch the academic - 2016 2017, the teaching process will be conducted in accordance with the teaching calendar, consequently instruction for all years of

study starts on September 2016. Teaching in winter semester will start from September 28 and will last until 1 January 2017. Winter semestral exam period starts from 08 February and ends on 12 February 2017. Teaching in summer semester shall be realized from 15 February to 31 May 2017 and the summer semester examination session begins on June 2017 ,8 and ends on June 2017 ,17.

5.2. Legal Service

Legal servise is a professional-administrative service whose main obligation is the activity to be fulfilled in accordance with the positive legislation in the field of higher education and in accordance with laws, procedures, mission, vision and quality standards of the University.

5.3. Library

International VISION University's Library in Gostivar has 28 computers, while digital library has a fund of about 5,000 publications which comprises materials and textbooks for all faculties.

Furthermore, the library has about 2000 printed editions of books that:

- *Faculty of Economics 350 books*
- *Faculty of Law: 400 books*
- *Faculty of Social Sciences: 350 books*
- *Faculty of Informatics: 260 books*
- *Faculty of Architecture: 150 books and bags full of material for drawing*

Among other literature library has monographs, periodicals, encyclopedias, as well as publications of a general culture. Users are provided with free access to library, comprising:

- *Current scientific literature;*
- *Academic collections of scientific literature;*
- *Reference collections of dictionaries, lexicons, bibliographies;*



- *Statistical publications;*
- *Official publications;*
- *Publications from international organizations;*
- *Publications NGOs*
- *Domestic and foreign professional magazines*
- *Daily newspapers*

Students of Architectural Faculty have the opportunity to take full books library with all the commodities needed for drawing.



In the University Library also are preparing materials for students in specific subject disciplines provided by the subject teachers from all units of the university. The students are allowed in the library to receive copies of the authorized lectures, scripts, documents, forms and other materials.



Accommodation Conditions

Those students who live outside of Gostivar have the option of accommodation at affordable rates in the downtown area just minutes from the University. The accommodation can absorb about 230 students, of which 150 in the women's facility, and 80 male students in the building. This accommodation offers safety, comfort and meets all the needs of students while studying and living.



Students can be accommodated in rooms with 2 or 3 beds with private bathroom.

In each of the two buildings there are:

- Place for laundry (washing)
- Libraries
- Wireless internet
- Provision (Provision and systems with cameras)
- 24- hours' hot water
- Technical services

The accommodation facilities serve students each morning have breakfast and weekly basic cleaning of the room accommodation.
